1. What records were kept for travel undertaken by the Minister for Education and Training, Mr Finch, between 1 June 1990 and 30 June 1990.
2. Which days, during the period referred to in question 1, did the minister spend in Darwin and which days were spent outside Darwin.
3. What travel did the minister undertake outside Darwin during that period.
4. To which places did the minister travel outside Darwin.
5. What was the means of travel.
6. What was the purpose of that travel.

7. Was any travel undertaken during that period for personal reasons.
8. If any travel was undertaken by light aircraft, what was the contractual relationship between the minister and the owner of the aircraft; specifically -
 - (a) which charter companies provided the service in the case of non-RPT flights;
 - (b) what was the cost of the service provided by charter flights;
 - (c) did the minister personally hire and fly aircraft for any of the travel undertaken during June 1990; if so, from whom was the aircraft hired; and
 - (d) if the minister did hire aircraft during this period, was it paid by him personally or by the Northern Territory government.
