To the Scrutiny Committee,

I am writing to ask that you refuse to allow for the NT to pass the Bill proposed by the NT CLP to introduce a Territory Coordinator.

As a long term resident of the NT, I ask that you dismiss this bill on grounds that it does not have sufficient regard for the rights of the NT people.

A bill such as this puts far too much power and control into the hands of people who potentially have very little education or authority to make important decisions about environmental risk.

I am appalled that the government would put at risk the liveability of the NT's delicate environment, and would seek to silence voices who may oppose them.

The government has a duty of care to look after the wellbeing of both current and future generations of Territorians. This duty of care should not elevate economic gain over environmental, social, and physical health and safety concerns, and for short term economic gain with low guarantee of positive outcomes.

Please take the time to scrutinise the long term effects of this Bill, and the implications of silencing third party voice and ability to raise objection.
