Subject: Prepayment and post-payment tariffs

QUESTION

What is the current prepayment tariff? What is the current tariff for post-payment households?

ANSWER

Electricity tariffs are set by the Northern Territory Government under the Electricity Pricing Order, issued by the Treasurer.

As per the Electricity Pricing Order 1 July 2025 - 30 June 2026, issued on 25 June 2025, the following tariffs apply:

Prescribed customer	Charge (cents/kWh)
Domestic – pre-payment meter tariff	33.0754
Domestic – standard tariff	30.0843

Domestic customers on a standard tariff also pay a fixed daily charge of \$0.5931. This daily charge does **not** apply to pre-payment customers.

Previous Tariffs (1 July 2024 – 30 June 2025):

As per the Electricity Pricing Order 1 July 2024 - 30 June 2025, issued on 26 June 2024:

Prescribed customer	Charge (cents/kWh)
Domestic – pre-payment meter tariff	32.1120
Domestic – standard tariff	29.2081

Domestic customers on a standard tariff also pay a fixed daily charge of \$0.5758. This daily charge does **not** apply to pre-payment customers.
