Subject: Homeland learning centres budget

QUESTION:

Can you provide a list of homeland learning centres that have had their infrastructure budget cut, the \$3.4 million that was allocated in the previous NT government's budget?

ANSWER:

\$2.230 million of the \$3.4 million identified in Budget 2024 for Homeland Learning Centres upgrades has been reprioritised under Budget 2025, with the difference committed for expenditure at various homeland learning centres by 30 June 2025.

The reprioritised funding was to be directed to Gutjangan (Bremer Island) Homeland Learning Centre. On completion of that project any remaining funding was intended to be directed to Mungkarta Homeland Learning Centre.
