Answer: Of the 38 businesses identified in the tabled document (DBERD ref 1-D2) 34 are currently operating.

There are currently four not operating:

- Emu Point Community - the community store is currently being built with anticipated commencement of operation in October 2007.
- Larrakia Development Corporation (Tibby Quall Fishing) - the original operator is no longer involved in the business. The Larrakia Development Corporation is currently investigating options for the business including an alternative Indigenous operator.
- Buddafly Textile - the proponent has decided not to go into business as planned, and has not accepted the grant.
- Aboriginal Air Services - no longer operating.
