What is the cost of maintenance for offices, for DCIS and for the other agencies that you have corporate services responsibilities?

What is the cost of office rental, and if you have the information available, can you please tell me the square metre size of each of the CEOs' office and the square metre sizes of those of all executive contract officers?

Answer: The cost to DCIS is nil for leased premises in respect to all agencies. The cost of building maintenance for leased property is the responsibility of the building owner.

In respect to DCIS occupied premises and the Government Printing Office building (Government owned building) the cost of maintenance of these offices totals \$197 000 as at May 2007.

Cost of office rental for each agency is as per that already tabled at estimates committee.

The square metre size of each CEO's office and executive contract officers across all agencies is not known to DCIS. However, in respect to DCIS, the size of the CEO's office is 35m<sup>2</sup>.
