2. **SCRUTINY OF ANNUAL REPORTS HEARINGS**

November 2017 Estimates Hearing Schedule

Once finalised the Chair will provide the Committee Secretary with a copy for dissemination to Agency Secretariats along with the *Draft November 2017 Estimates Hearing Schedule* by close of business Monday, 2 October 2017. Both schedules are to be clearly marked *Draft – Subject to Approval of the Assembly* until the Assembly removes the time limits for individual Ministers.

- It was agreed that the Committee Secretariat will provide a brief analysis of each report to be considered utilising the *Annual Report Compliance* templates included in the *Briefing Note on Options for Hearing on Annual Reports* (Meeting Papers 6).
