**ANSWER**

The government has committed \$5m to upgrade homeland schools across the Northern Territory and in 2017–18 seven Yirkala homelands communities will share \$1m for repairs and upgrades of their schools to improve the learning facilities for their students and the master plan for the Yirkala homeland schools will guide this work to improve facilities and homeland learning centres out there. This additional \$1m is on top of the regular school repairs and maintenance programs.
