Could you advise the current Indigenous life expectancy rates in the NT and could you advise of rates ten years ago?

Life expectancy estimates are available to 2012.

Between the two periods 2001-2005 and 2011-2012, life expectancy for NT Aboriginal males improved from 59.9 years to 63.2 years.

For the same period, life expectancy for NT Aboriginal women improved from 66.8 years to 68.9 years
