Question: How much is the connecting head works costing – road works, sewer, power, everything that is needed to build that hospital, but not included in the \$133m and \$50m figures? I just wanted to clarify, you gave us a figure totalling \$28m, but we would like the total cost of all trunk infrastructure, head works, however you want to term it.

Intersection: Stuart Highway & Temple Terrace	\$11.0M
Glyde Point, Holtze Collector & PRH Access Roads	\$10.M
Water	\$3.85M
Power & Telecommunications	\$2.60M
Stormwater	\$2.65M
Sewer	\$2.90M
Total Headworks (trunk infrastructure)	\$33.0M

In addition to servicing the Palmerston Regional Hospital, the aforementioned headworks will augment existing road, water and power networks and will contribute to services required for future development in the Holtze region.

¹ As construction contracts are yet to be awarded for all of the headworks, the above figures are estimates informed by actual costs where known.
